Members are advised that as of 1 December 2021, ambrisentan, bosentan, macitentan, sildenafil and tadalafil for pulmonary arterial hypertension dual therapy will no longer be PBS subsidised for patients wishing to commence treatment under the

grandfathered PBS restrictions.
