The ANZ Cardiac Device and Complications Committee's (ANZCDACC) latest report is on the Medtronic Cobalt™ and Crome™ Product Defect Correction. A small number of SmartSync interrogation sessions, or CareLink network transmissions may fail for Cobalt or Crome devices when the current session diagnostic data includes any VT/VF episode type with multiple therapy sequences and three or more data recording suspensions.





CONGRATULATIONS | NSW Woman of Excellence Award





New dates have been announced for the much anticipated 2022 HEART Course



targeted towards ATs and BPTs in Sydney. The 2-day course will run across the weekend of 2-3 July, 2022.
