mission.



the echocardiographic diagnosis of rheumatic heart disease (RHD). The purpose of this tool was to standardize RHD diagnosis internationally. A decade has now passed since this publication and these criteria have been used across a variety of clinical and

research settings.


This survey is designed to understand how the 2012 WHF RHD ECHO Criteria are currently being used and how we can improve the next version to better meet the needs of the research and clinical community.


