Street Side Medics is a drop-in clinic service, operated from a mobile medical van, which delivers targeted healthcare at homeless food services, shelters, temporary accommodations, and disaster-affected zones in New South Wales. These “drop-in”

outreach clinics make healthcare considerably more accessible.

This was the vision of Dr. Daniel Nour, who founded Street Side Medics in August 2020, and for which he won Young Australian of the Year in 2022, recognising the early success of the service.




