VALE: Dr Ronald Newman Easthope FCSANZ



It is with deep regret that we note the passing of Dr Ron Easthope on 23 August 2022.

Dr Easthope was a dedicated cardiologist at Wellington Hospital for over 30 years and after his retirement in 2000 he was the hospital's honorary archivist and enthusiastic member of the Wellington Medical Historical Society.

Dr Easthope began his career as a Cardiology Registrar. He moved to London and took up the position of Cardiology Registrar at the National Heart Hospital in 1966, which later became attached to the Hospital for Sick Children, Great Ormond Street.





