To briefly reiterate, the CSANZ Board is reviewing the strategic priorities for the society. A short survey has been prepared to inform the Board about what areas you consider important that should be prioritised and resourced.

Note that core areas of business such as developing guidelines and practice standards, education and training, and science and research support will continue to be strategic priorities and are not included in the survey.

The survey covers several issues that have arisen in various fora over the past 12 months.

WARFARIN SHORTAGE IN AUSTRALIA | UPDATE

We are currently in consultation with TGA, and understand that there are a number of shortages including:

- **Coumadin 5 mg tablets until end of July**
- **Coumadin 2 mg tablets until end of April**
- **Marevan 3 mg tablets until 10 March 2023**

TGA are actively working with suppliers and chemists to ensure that appropriate stocks remain. We are aware that some patients are attending multiple pharmacies and that some patients may have to undertake a temporary substitution in either formulation or individual tablet dosage. This may require more frequent monitoring and we have communicated to the media that patients should consult with their prescribing doctor.

We have strongly advocated to TGA the importance of warfarin to many patients, and have

requested that they investigate approaches which permit them to communicate to patients where warfarin is accessible.

We'll keep you posted with any more developments.
