The Australasian Cardiac Outcomes Registry (ACOR) are currently implementing milestones and deliverables to expand the scope of the Registry to a multi-valvular Registry combining four valves of the heart; aortic, mitral, pulmonary and tricuspid. South Australia's Health and Medical Research Institute (SAHMRI) continues to be ACOR's Registry Operator.

ACOR have also recently submitted a request for tender for the provision of Clinical Quality Registry (CQR) Services (Stream 1 of the National CQR Program), which facilitated important discussions around the growth and priorities of the Registry.

This statement provides updated information regarding the previously released November 2023 advisory as a larger number of devices are now affected.

HLC: New format for concise original research articles: Focused Research Reports

Focused Research Reports are expedited original research articles describing a discrete set of preclinical laboratory experiments or prospectively designed clinical study addressing a focused aim.

Manuscripts will have a maximum of 900 words, 7 references and only 1 figure (6 panels, 1page max) or 1 table (1page max). Figure legend or Table legend limited to 400 words. Materials and methods must be explanatory within the body of text and may

be supported by accessible references. Do not include an abstract. Do not include appendices with supplemental data, materials and methods. The need to report additional material indicates the need to submit a regular format original manuscript. Statements to be made at the end of the report include the following details: Research Ethics Approval, Funding Acknowledgements, Detailed Methods and Data Availability ('The detailed materials and methods, and data that support the findings of this study are available from the corresponding author upon reasonable request'); Disclosures (financial or other conflicts of interest).
